For R1 to R3 : Mr.V.Neelakandan

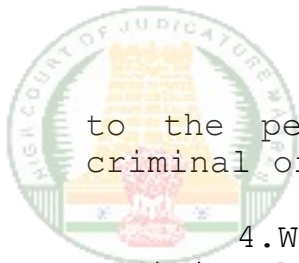
