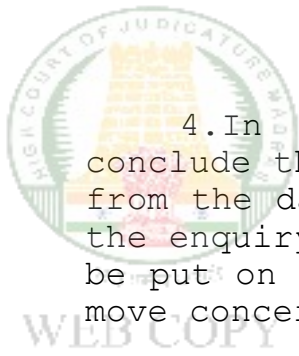

2.The case of the petitioner is that there is a civil dispute between the petitioner and the fourth respondent. At this stage, the fourth respondent has also given a complaint before the third respondent.
