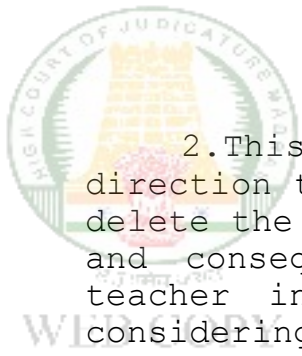

2.This writ petition has been filed to issue appropriate direction to the second respondent to direct the third respondent to delete the word "self finance" in 6th standard English Medium Section and consequently to delete the word surplus in Tamil graduate teacher in the staff strength for the standard 6th to 10th by considering the representation of the petitioner dated 20.01.2020.

3.Mr.R.Devaraj, learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that though the petitioner has made a representation on **(*)20.01.2020**, no decision has been taken by the second respondent till date. Hence, without any other option, the petitioner approached this Court by virtue of this judicial review petition.

4.Mr.N.Shanmugaselvan, learned Additional Government Pleader appearing for the respondents fairly submits that the said representation will be disposed of on merits and in accordance with law within a period of four weeks.

5.Considering the submission made by the learned counsel appearing on either side, this Court directs the second respondent to dispose of the representation dated **(*)20.01.2020** within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, on merits and in accordance with law.

6.With the above directions, this Writ Petition is disposed of. No costs.
