PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

PRAYER :-

For an Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.9 of 2020 on the file of the respondent police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioner is a sole accused apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under section 12 of POCSO Act, 2012, in Crime No.9 of 2020 on the file of the respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.

2. Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate (criminal side) appearing for the respondent.

3. The petitioner had earlier moved the anticipatory bail before this Court on 20.08.2020 in Cr10.P.(MD) No. 8681 of 2020 and on 10.09.2020 in Cr1.O.P.(MD) No. 9536 of 2020 and the same were dismissed. This is the third application for anticipatory bail.

4. Since there is no change in circumstances, this Court is not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Accordingly,

the Criminal Original Petition stands dismissed. The petitioner has committed very serious and heinous offence as against the minor victim girl and therefore, the respondent police is directed to secure the petitioner/accused and proceed in accordance with law.
