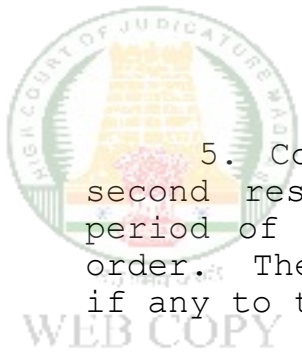
O R D E R

3. By Order, dated 09.10.2020, this Court directed the first respondent/Superintendent of Police, Dindigul District, to file a status report.
