2.The petitioner wants the petition mentioned religious event to be conducted. It appears that there are some objections from rival classes. In a connected matter filed by the rival party, I had directed the jurisdictional Tahsildar to convene a peace committee meeting and ensure that the event is conducted. I had made it clear that no one will be entitled for first respect or first honour. Therefore, I am of the view that the present Writ Petition can also be disposed of on the same lines.

3.The Jurisdictional Tahsildar shall convene a peace committee meeting. The third respondent will also associate himself in the process. All the stakeholders will be invited for the peace



committee meeting and all possible steps should be taken to ensure that the petition mentioned religious event is conducted in a smooth manner.

4. With this direction, the Writ Petition is disposed of.
