4.Therefore, the respondents are directed not to harass the petitioner in the name of enquiry. This Criminal Original Petition stands allowed.

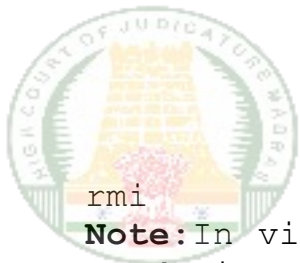
