This Court by an order dated 19.11.2019 has directed the learned Judicial Magistrate, Rajapalayam, Virudhunagar District to dispose of the case in D.V.C.No.15 of 2019, within a period of six months, on a quash petition filed by the accused. The petitioner as a defacto complainant has filed a petition under Section 19 (r) of the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act 2005 in the above D.V.C.No.15 of 2019. Already there is an order by this Court.

2. The Registry is directed to get a Status Report from the learned Judicial Magistrate, Rajapalayam, Virudhunagar District and place before this Court by 10.12.2020.

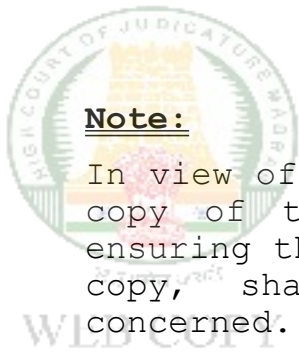
