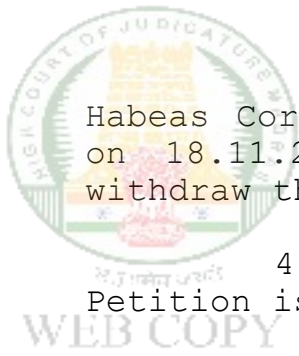
[Order of the Court was made by K.KALYANASUNDARAM, J.]
