5.With this direction to the second respondent, this Criminal Original Petition is disposed of.

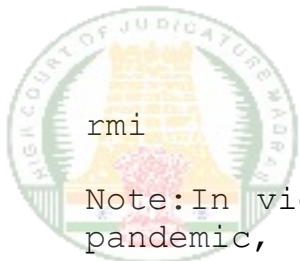
