Prayer: Writ petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, to issue a Writ of Mandamus, to direct the first respondent to direct the third respondent not to disturb the construction works of the petitioner's purchased lands in Survey No.66/3 of Nelveli Village, Manamelkudi Taluk, Pudukkottai District and its extent of 0.12.25 ares within a stipulated time limit.

some dispute between the fifth respondent and his brother the sixth respondent/Ravichandran. According to the petitioner, at the instance of the sixth respondent, the third respondent is coercing him not to proceed with the construction.

3. When the matter was taken up for hearing, the learned Government Advocate stated that the third respondent has never interfered and will not interfere in the pending civil dispute.

4. Recording the said submission, this writ petition is disposed of. No costs.
