Therefore, the petition mentioned enquiry shall be concluded within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. The third respondent will issue summons in writing, if he wants to enquire the petitioners. There cannot be any oral summon for attending enquiry. If the third respondent registers any FIR, the petitioners will be given due notice, so that, the petitioners will have breathing time to move the concerned Court for the relief of anticipatory bail.

5. With this direction, these criminal original petitions are disposed of.
