PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

PRAYER :-For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.495 of 2020 on the file of the respondent police

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioners, who are arrayed as A1 to A3, apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offence punishable under Sections 279, 353, 379 of I.P.C., and Sections 4(1) (1A) and 21(1) of Tamil Nadu Mines and Minerals (Development and Regulation), Act, 1957, and Section 179 of Motor Vehicles Act, in Crime No.495 of 2020, seek anticipatory bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that the petitioners said to have illegally transported two units of river sand by using Tempo Van. Hence, a case has been registered.

3.Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioners and the learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) appearing for the respondent Police.



4. In view of the order passed in Crl.O.P.No.13334 of 2020 etc., batch, dated 03.09.2020 by the Principal Bench of this Court at Madras, this Court is not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

5. Accordingly, this criminal original petition stands dismissed.
