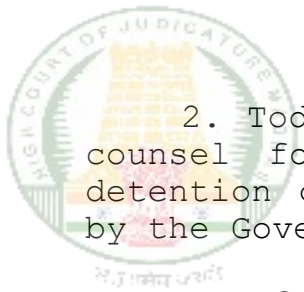

The petitioner has filed the habeas corpus petition seeking to quash the proceedings of the second respondent in No. B.C.D.F.G.I.S.S.S.V.No.25/2020 dated 16.10.2020 branding the detenu viz., his husband, Rajkumar, son of Selvam, aged about 26 years, as a "Sand Offender" as contemplated under Section 2(gg) of Tamil Nadu Act, 14 of 1982, detained him at the Central Prison, Madurai and to set him at liberty.



2. Today, when the matter is taken up for hearing, the learned counsel for the petitioner Mr.R.Alagumani would state that the detention order impugned in this habeas corpus petition is revoked by the Government.

3. Recording the above submission, the habeas corpus petition is closed.
