Prayer in CRL MP(MD). No.5931 of 2020 :-

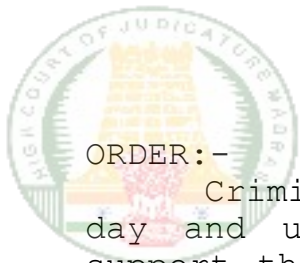
