PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

PRAYER :- For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.184 of 2019 on the file of the Respondent Police

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioner, who is arrayed as A1, apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Section 6(4) of TNSC (RDCS) Order 1982 r/w Section 7(i)(a)(II) of Essential Commodities Act, 1955, in Crime No.184 of 2019 on the file of the respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that the petitioner and others were found in illegal possession of 285 Plastic Bags of rice (each contains 50 kgs). Hence, the crime has been registered.

3.Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate (Crl. side) appearing for the respondent.

4.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is an innocent person and he has not committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution and he has been falsely implicated in this case. Hence, he prayed for grant of anticipatory



5.The learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) appearing for the respondent police submitted that there are three previous cases pending against the petitioner of similar in nature.

6.Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and also considering the fact that there are three previous cases pending against the petitioner of similar in nature and the petitioner is a habitual offender, hence, this Court is not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

7.Accordingly, this Criminal Original Petition stands dismissed.
