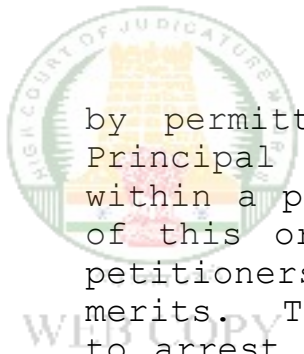
O R D E R

by permitting the petitioners to surrender before the learned Principal District and Sessions Judge (PCR Court), Dindigul, within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. The learned District Judge will dispose of the petitioners' bail petition on the same day of surrender on its own merits. There will be a direction to the respondents 1 and 2 not to arrest the petitioners till the expiry of the period of eight weeks.
