PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C.

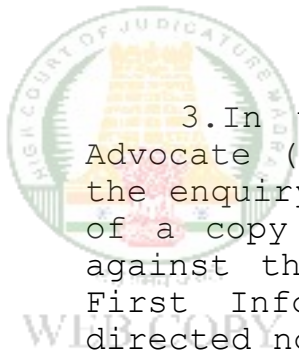
PRAYER :-

For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No. Not Known of 2020 on the file of the Respondent Police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioners, who are arrayed as A1 to A4, apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offence punishable under Sections 498(A), 294(b) IPC., and Section 4 of TNDP Act, in Crime No. Not known of 2020, on the file of the respondent Police, seek anticipatory bail.

2.When the matter is taken up for hearing, the learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) appearing for the respondent police submitted that petition enquiry is pending against the petitioners.



3. In view of the submission made by the learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side), the respondent police is directed to complete the enquiry, within a period of three weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order and if any prima facie case is made out against the petitioners, the respondent police shall register the First Information Report. Till then, the respondent police is directed not to arrest the petitioners.

4. Accordingly, this Criminal Original Petition is disposed of.
