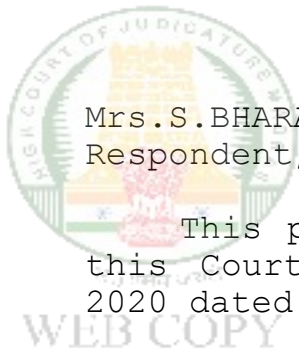
PRAYER IN CRL MP(MD)No.3521 of 2020 IN CRL A(MD)No.219 of 2020:
