ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioner/accused, who apprehend arrest at the hands of

379 of IPC and Section 21(1) of Mines and Minerals(Development and
Regulation) Act, 1957 seeks anticipatory bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that the petitioner was found
in illegal possession of 100 gunny bags of river sand.

3.In view of the order passed in Crl.O.P.No.13334 of 2020 etc.,
batch, dated 03.09.2020 by the Principal Bench of this Court at
Madras, this Court is not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the
petitioner.



4. Accordingly, this criminal original petition stands dismissed.
