When the matter was taken up for hearing, the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that this Court vide order dated 14.07.2020, allowed the condone delay petition, by imposing a condition of payment of cost to the respondent counsel. It is stated that the learned counsel for the petitioner could not contact the



petitioner, as the petitioner has gone to his native place to attend the condolence of his grand mother and hence, there was a delay in paying the cost to the learned counsel for the respondent. The petitioner has now paid the cost to the respondent counsel on 03.11.2020 and prayed the delay to be condoned.

2.On the side of the respondent, it is admitted that the cost was received by the learned counsel for the respondent.

3.In view of the above submission, the petition is allowed and the time for payment of cost was extended as prayed for.
