Prayer: Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India to issue a writ of mandamus, forbearing the respondents 1 and 2 herein, their men, agents or any one claiming under them from in any manner interfering with the business of the petitioner in the tenanted 2nd floor portion of Dr.No. 171, East Veli St., Madurai-625001, without following the due process of law and consequently direct the respondents herein to receive the monthly rent of Rs. 5000/- pm., from the petitioner for the 2nd floor portion of Dr.No. 171, East Veli St., Madurai-1, in his occupation till the final outcome of the dispute before the Special Court under the TNPID Act, Madurai.

This writ petition has been filed seeking a writ of mandamus forbearing the respondents 1 and 2 from in any manner interfering with the business of the petitioner and for consequential directions

2.The petitioner contends that she has been in occupation of the second floor at Door No.171, East Veli Street, Madurai- 625001, as a tenant and the landlord, who is doing business in the names of K.L.K. and K.R.S.Finance, is facing the proceedings under TNPID Act. However, the petitioner, being a tenant for a long period, in the above said property, has been asked to vacate the premises, vide impugned order, dated 04.11.2020 and therefore the petitioner has approached this Court.

3.Heard Mr.K.Muthu Ganesa Pandian, learned Counsel appearing for the petitioner and Mr.M.Muthugeethaiyan, learned Special Government Pleader appearing for the respondents.

4.It is evident from the records that the petitioner is in occupation of the above said property for a long period and therefore, her possession cannot be disturbed. However, it is open to the petitioner to approach the Special Court under TNPID Act, under Section 10(b) of TNPID Act, seeking permission to carry on her business.

5.Under such circumstances, this Court directs the petitioner to approach the Special Court under TNPID Act, Madurai, under Section 10(b) of the TNPID Act, seeking permission to carry on her business and it is open to the petitioner to deposit the rent before the said Court. The Special Court under TNPID Act, Madurai, on filing of such application by the petitioner as directed above, shall dispose of the said application as expeditiously as possible. Till such time, the petitioner's possession shall not be disturbed.

6.The writ petition is disposed of, on the above terms. No costs. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petition is closed.
