Prayer: Contempt Petition is filed under Section 11 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, to punish the Contemnors/Respondents in accordance with law for their willful disobedience of the order in W.P(MD)No.24503 of 2018 dated 12.12.2018.



Prayer in WP(MD). 24503/ 2018 :

Writ Petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying this Court To issue a Writ of Mandamus, directing the respondents to grant the petitioner 4th and 5th review benefits and revise his pay in the post of Checking Inspector with retrospective effect from 01.09.2010 in terms of Government Order in G.O.Ms.No.61 Transport (C1) Department dated 30.04.2015 and as per 12(3) Settlement dated 22.1.2011 and further directing the respondents to pay the petitioner difference amount in his salary from 01.09.2010 to 31.03.2015 and to pay difference in his retirement benefits including difference in monthly pension, Gratuity, Leave Salary. Commuted Value of Pension and all other attendant benefits payable to the petitioner from 31.03.2015 to till date together with interest at the rate of 18% per annum.
