4.Considering the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioners, without advertting to the merits of the case, the respondent police are directed to dispose of the petitioners'



representation dated 28.08.2020, within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order on merits and in accordance with law, as per the Police Standing Orders and communicate the decision taken to the petitioners.

5. With the above direction, these Writ Petitions are disposed of.
