PRAYER IN CRL MP(MD)No.2411 of 2020 in CRL A(MD) No.25 of 2020:

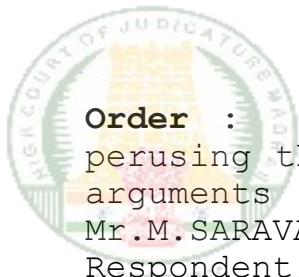

Petition filed praying that in the circumstances stated therein and in the petition filed therewith the High Court may be pleased to Suspend the sentence alone imposed in S.C.No.38 of 2013 dated 12/12/2019 on the file of the Sessions Judge, Special Court for Exclusive Trial of Cases under Registered SC/ST POA Act 1989, Sivagangai pending disposal of the above Criminal Appeal and thus render justice.

PRAYER IN CRL A(MD)No.25 of 2020:

Pleased to set aside the conviction and sentence imposed by the Sessions Judge, Special Court for Exclusive Trial of Cases under Registered SC/ST POA Act in S.C.No.38 of 2013 dated 12.12.2019 and acquit the appellant.
