5.Recording the above submission made by the learned Government Advocate (Criminal side), without going into the merits of the case, the respondent police are directed to consider and dispose of on the petitioner's representation dated 10.11.2020 after giving opportunity to the respondents 5 to 12 by following the principles laid down by the Hon'ble Apex Court in **D.K.Basu Vs. State of West Bengal reported in AIR (1997) SC 610** within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

6.With the above direction, this Writ Petition is disposed of.
