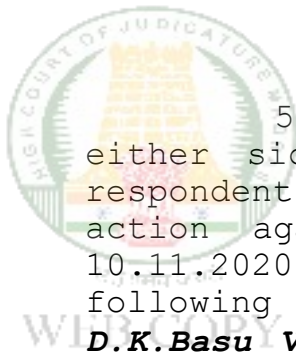
O R D E R

State of West Bengal reported in AIR (1997) SC 610**. The said exercise shall be completed within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order
