This Criminal Original Petition is dismissed as withdrawn

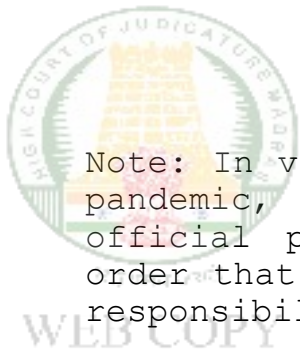
