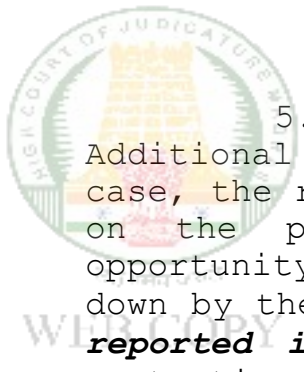
O R D E R

This Criminal Original Petition has been filed to direct the 2nd respondent to provide adequate police protection to the petitioner and her husband namely Dinesh based on the representation dated 02.12.2020.

2.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner reiterated the contentions set out in the original petition.

3.The learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing on behalf of the respondents 1 & 2, on instructions, would submit that the complaint of the petitioner has been received by the respondent police and CSR No.729 of 2020 has been assigned on 09.12.2020 and the enquiry is pending.

4.Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondents 1 & 2. Since no adverse order is going to be passed, notice to the 3rd respondent is dispensed with.



5.Recording the above submission made by the learned Additional Public Prosecutor, without going into the merits of the case, the respondents 1 & 2 are directed to consider and pass orders on the petitioner's complaint dated 02.12.2020 after giving opportunity to the other side, by following the principles laid down by the Hon'ble Apex Court in ***D.K.Basu Vs. State of West Bengal reported in AIR (1997) SC 610*** and if it is found that police protection is necessary, the same may be given to the petitioner. The said exercise shall be completed within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

6.With the above directions, this criminal original petition is disposed of.
