2. Considering the reasons stated in the letter dated 05.05.2022, a further time of four months is granted from today to dispose of HMOP.No.11 of 2019.

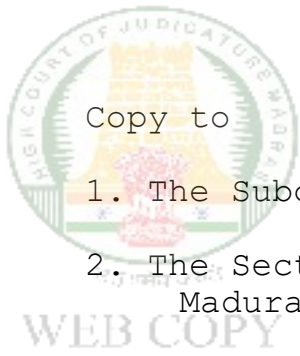
