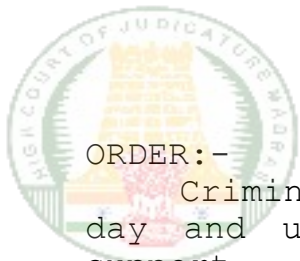
Prayer in CRL MP(MD). No.4486 of 2020 :
