ORDER

2. According to the petitioner, though he made a representation dated 13.07.2019, with the relief sought for in the prayer, so far, no action has been taken. Hence, left with no other alternative, the petitioner is before this Court.

The petitioner is directed to enclose a copy of this order along with such representation.

5. This Writ Petition is disposed of, with the above direction. No costs.
