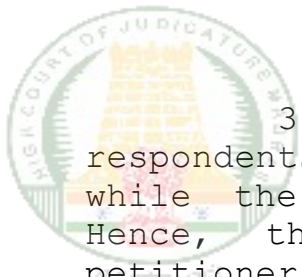

ORDER

2. Heard the learned Counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate appearing for the first respondent.



3. The learned Government Advocate appearing for the respondents would submit that there was law and order problem while the petitioner was conducting the festival last year. Hence, the first respondent rejected the request of the petitioner.

The first respondent police is directed to conduct a peace committee meeting by giving opportunity to the petitioner as well as the second respondent in the light of the order of this Court in W.P.(MD)No.24777 of 2019, dated 18.12.2019. The petitioner would abide by the conditions which the first respondent may stipulate.

5. The writ petition stands disposed of with the above directions. However, there shall be no order as to costs.
