2. The writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn and the liberty is granted to the petitioner. No costs.

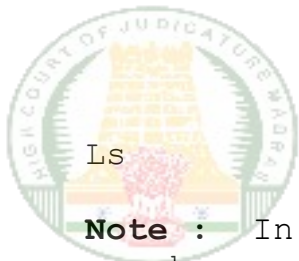
