5. In view of the submission made by the learned counsel on either side, this Court is inclined to pass the following direction:-

the respondents are directed to consider the petitioner's representations, dated 30.09.2020 and 03.12.2020 and dispose of the same on merits and in accordance with law, within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order;

6.With the above direction, the Writ Petition stands disposed of. No costs.
