PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

PRAYER :- For Anticipatory Bail in Crime no.1684 of 2020 on the
file of the respondent police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the
learned Government Advocate(Crl. Side) appearing for the respondent.

2. The petitioner apprehending arrest at the hands of the
respondent police for the offences punishable under sections 8(c)
r/w. 20(b), (ii) (b) of NDPS Act, in Crime No.1684 of 2020 on the
file of the respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.

3. On reading of the FIR shows that the petitioners along with
others were found in possession of contraband and preparing package
for sale. The petitioner ran away from the place of occurrence when
the officials approached them. According to the petitioners, the
respondent police are not at all present in the place of occurrence and



only on the confession statement of the Co-accused, the petitioner was arrayed as accused. But the FIR shows that the petitioner was also present in the scene of occurrence and ran away, on seeing the officials.

4. Since prima facie materials are available against the petitioner, this Court is not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Accordingly, this Criminal Original Petition is dismissed.
