Prayer in CRP(MD)NO.1015 of 2016:

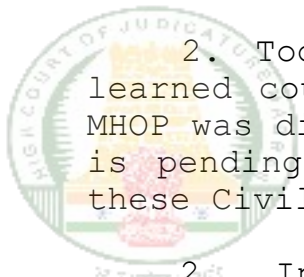
