4. In this case, the complaint has been given on 12.09.2016 and the matter is pending for nearly four years. Now, due to efflux of time, nothing remains to be adjudicated in the present petition



and hence, this Criminal Original Petition is dismissed. However, if at all any disturbance in future, it is always open to the petitioner to file a fresh complaint to the second respondent police.
