ORDER

2.The learned counsel for the petitioner as well as the respondents have no objections for issuing a direction to the second respondent to consider the petitioner's representation, dated 13.10.2014 in accordance with law within a time stipulated by this Court.



3.Having regard to the limited scope of the prayer that is now sought for before this Court by the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner without going into the merits of the petitioner's representation, dated 13.10.2014, this Court is inclined to issue the following direction.

(i)The second respondent is directed to consider the petitioner's representation, dated 13.10.2014 on merits and in accordance with law and pass appropriate orders, within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.
