It appears that the third accused had impersonated the said person. The petitioner is said to be the key person behind the entire operation. Therefore, these two cases have been filed.

3. The question of quashing the same does not arise. Only after the charge sheet is filed, one can weigh the material against the petitioner herein and grant relief. Even at the stage of investigation, it is not possible to quash the proceedings.

4. Leaving open all the petitioner's contentions and defences, the criminal original petitions stand dismissed. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petitions are closed.
