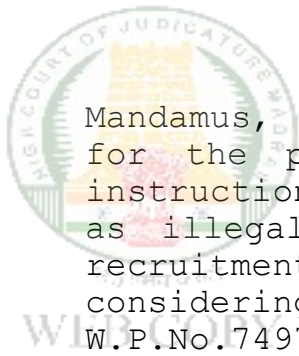

Mandamus, calling for the records pertaining to the tentative list for the post driver published by the third respondent on the instructions of the second respondent dated nil and quash the same as illegal and consequently, directing the respondents to start recruitment afresh by issuing fresh open notification after considering the petitioner's candidature as per the order in W.P.No.7497 of 2009, dated 11.11.2009 conformed in W.A.No.823 of 2013, dated 19.08.2013.

Prayer in W.P. (MD)No.8202 of 2015: Writ petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, to issue a Writ of Certiorarified Mandamus, calling for the records pertaining to the tentative list for the post driver published by the fourth respondent on the instruction of the third respondent dated nil and quash the same as illegal and consequently directing the respondents to start recruitment afresh by issuing fresh open notification after considering the petitioner's candidature by relaxing age without sponsor from Employment Exchange.
