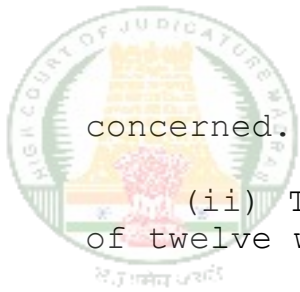
ORDER

This writ petition is filed seeking for a direction to direct the respondents to dispose the appeal filed by the petitioner in Na.Ka.No.A3/2884/2016, dated 25.06.2019 and issue fresh patta.

2.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner would submit that it is suffice, if a direction is issued to the first respondent to dispose the appeal filed by the petitioner in Na.Ka.No.A3/2884/2016, dated 25.06.2018.

3.The learned Additional Government Pleader appearing for the respondents would submit that the petitioner's appeal is now pending for enquiry and the same would be considered on merits and in accordance with law, within a time frame to be fixed by this Court.

4.Considering the submissions made on either side, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this Court is inclined to directs the first respondent to consider the petitioner's appeal dated 25.06.2019 and pass appropriate orders on merits and in accordance with law, after affording due opportunity of hearing to the petitioner and the rival parties, if any. If there is any objection from the rival parties, the first respondent shall conduct the enquiry and communicate the decision to the parties



concerned.

(ii) The aforesaid exercise shall be completed within a period of twelve weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

5. This Writ Petition is disposed of, with the above directions. No costs.
