4.The Writ petition is disposed of on these terms. No costs.

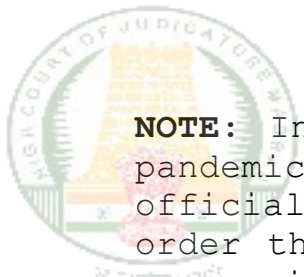
