2.The learned Government Advocate (Crl.side) appearing for the respondents 1 to 4 submitted that on the complaint lodged by the petitioner, the fourth respondent police has registered a case in Crime No.533 of 2016. After registering the FIR, the investigation has been completed and the same was closed as "Action Dropped" by the fourth respondent. Therefore, nothing survives in this petition.

3.Recording the submissions made by the learned Government Advocate (Crl.side), this Writ Petition is dismissed as devoid of merits. However, the petitioner is at liberty to file a protest petition, before the concerned jurisdictional Magistrate, in the manner known to law. No costs.
