3.It is seen that there is a civil dispute pending between the petitioner and the respondents 3 and 4 herein in respect of the land in Nanja in Survey No.492/11, Punja in Survey No.378/10 with two houses in Nainaragaram Village, Kadaiyanallur Taluk, Tirunelveli District. Therefore, the first and second respondents have no role to play in the civil dispute pending between the petitioner and the respondents 3 and 4 herein. As such, the first and second respondents are directed not to interfere with the civil dispute pending between the petitioner and the respondents 3 and 4 herein except any crime committed by the petitioner and the respondents 3 and 4.

4.With the above directions, this Writ Petition stands disposed of. No costs. Consequently, the connected writ miscellaneous petition is closed.
