To grant an interim direction to the Madurai Municipal
Corporation to forthwith provide water connection and drainage

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facility to the multifunction complex in the Madurai railway junction by receiving the necessary fees and charges towards such services from the petitioner pending disposal of the main writ petition.

Prayer in WP(MD). 18477/ 2018 :

Writ Petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying this Court To issue a Writ of Certiorarified Mandamus to calling for records relating to the impugned demand notice of the 1st respondent singed on 03.03.2018 and quash the same and consequently direct the Madurai Municipality corporation to provide water connection and drainage facility to the multifunction complex located in the Madurai railway junction upon payment of fees and charges towards such services.

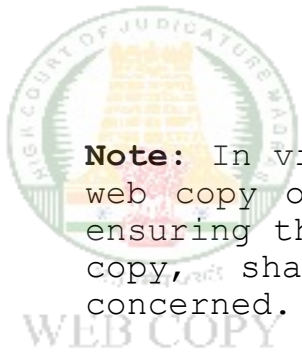
