### **O R D E R**

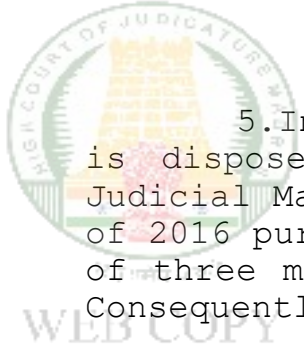
#### **(Thro' VC)**
