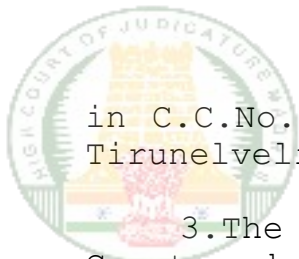

O R D E R

This Criminal Original Petition has been filed to call for records relating to the case in C.C.No.268 of 2016 pending on the file of the Additional Mahila Court, Tirunelveli and quash the same.

2.The second respondent / defacto complainant, as well as the petitioners/accused are present before this Court and they are identified by the respective learned counsel and both the parties have filed a joint compromise memo stating that the matter has been amicably resolved between themselves and the second respondent / defacto complainant is not willing to prosecute the complaint and the petitioner would pray for quashing the charge sheet



in C.C.No.268 of 2016, on the file of the Additional Mahila Court, Tirunelveli.

3.The compromise memo, dated 23.12.2020 is filed before this Court and the parties along with their respective counsel are also personally present before this Court today(23.12.2020) and the defacto complainant has represented before this Court that the matter has been settled amicably between the parties. The learned Government Advocate who was present in the Court had also verified their identity and would state that he has no objection for the above compromise.

4.In the result, by recording the compromise, the Criminal Original Petition is allowed and the charge-sheet in C.C.No.268 of 2016, on the file of the Additional Mahila Court, Tirunelveli, is quashed. The joint compromise memo shall form part and parcel of this order. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petitions are closed.
