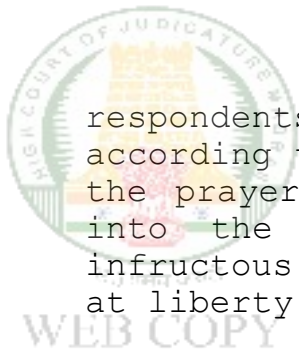

2.When the matter is taken up for hearing, the learned counsel for the respondents submitted that the prayer has become infructuous. However, the learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that the tuition fee, which has been collected by the



respondents, has got to be refunded for the 4th semester, since even according to the respondents, the petitioner has not studied. Since the prayer itself has become infructuous, this Court has not gone into the said aspect and the writ petition is dismissed as infructuous. However, if the petitioner has got any grievance, he is at liberty to approach the appropriate forum. No costs.
