**ORDER**

This Criminal Original Petition has been filed to quash the proceedings in S.T.C No.66 of 2019 on the file of the Judicial Magistrate No.I, Dindigul District for the offences under Sections 145, 188 and 341 IPC.

2.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioners would submit that the facts of the case are exactly similar to the case covered in the decision reported in **2018 2 LW (Cr1) 606 [Jeevanandham and others vs. The Inspector of Police Velayuthampalayam Police Station, Karur District] dated 20.09.2018** and in the case of **Sri Raja vs Inspector of Police, Sivakasi Town Police Station Virudhunagar District and other** in batch of cases in **Cr1.O.P(MD) No.7922 of 2019 dated 30.08.2019**

3. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondent police would submit that the facts of the case are similar to the facts covered under the Judgment referred above.

4.Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondent police and perused the materials on record.

5.The facts of this case is similar to the facts covered by the Judgment of this Court reported in **2018 2 LW (Cr1) 606 [Jeevanandham and others vs. The Inspector of Police Velayuthampalayam Police Station, Karur District] dated 20.09.2018** and in case of **Sri Raja vs Inspector of Police, Sivakasi Town Police Station Virudhunagar District and other in batch of cases in Cr1.O.P(MD) No.7922 of 2019 dated 30.08.2019**. Accordingly, the proceedings in STC No.664 of 2019 on the file of the Judicial Magistrate No.I, Dindigul District is hereby quashed insofar as the petitioners alone and the Criminal Original Petition is allowed.
